I read the Newsletter "Traitor or Faithful Servant" with great interest and a great sense of joy because the problem that you pose, I had just read about a few days earlier in Acts 21. I have a Lutheran explanatory Bible printed in 1974, which has the following to say (in German) about verse 20:

"Die Worte des Jakobus zeigen, dass um 57 n. Chr., also nicht ganz drei Jahrzehnte nach Jesu Kreuzigung, die Jerusalemer christliche Gemeinde nicht nur noch im Gespräch mit der Judenschaft steht, sondern dass es ihr bislang sogar gelungen ist, zahlreiche Juden, besonders der pharisäischen Richtung, für den Glauben an Jesus Christus zu gewinnen. Diese Christen, selbst Juden (i.e. die selbst Juden waren), verlangten von ihren Brüdern, die zur christlichen Gemeinde stießen, nicht, dass sie ihr Judesein aufgaben. Das wirkt auf uns befremdend, weil wir Heidenchristen in über 1800 Jahren die Meinung gebildet haben, wer als Jude Christ werde, gebe damit sein Judentum auf – gewiss zunächst »religiös«, aber damit auch in völkischer Hinsicht. Demgegenüber haben wir heute von diesem Teil der frühen Christenheit zu lernen, dass wir »Christen aus den Heiden« (Römer 11, 11ff) von einem Juden, der Christ wird, nicht verlangen dürfen, dass er sein Judesein aufgibt, sondern dass wir ihn, wie die Gemeinde damals, als Christ auch Jude sein lassen. Glaubt er wirklich an Jesus Christus, ist das Gesetz für ihn nicht mehr Heilsweg. Aber sonst bleibt er Angehöriger des alten Gottesvolkes, das zusammen mit den [Christus angehörenden] Heiden das neue Gottesvolk sein soll und wird (Römer 11, 25ff; Epheser 2, 14ff)."

So I quite agree with you that a Messianic Jew should never relinquish his being a Jew.

May the Lord be with you always and be your counsel and guide as He has been.

Shalom dear Jacob and Elisheva,

Thank you so much for your newsletter. I was very touched by what you wrote Jacob. You wrote so expressively and punchy so that by reading your letter, I felt like being with you in the story; [...] my heart cried for joy when you wrote how they prayed and read in the Siddur and in the Torah.

I felt their cry for G-D, and their desire of HIS presence, just as Paul writes in his letter to the Romans 10:2: "I bear them record that they have a zeal of God ...".

And our father GOD has a deep love for HIS chosen people, for the Jews. He "never will fail, nor forsake" the descendents of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Jos 1:5).

Jacob, I was touched by your request, that we pagan Christians should allow you to keep the Jewish laws and the Torah. What a humble request. But instead of your request we should ask you to teach us the Torah, so that we learn from it and use it for our lives Yeshua said (Matth 5:17 f):

"Think not that I have come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I have not come to destroy, but to fulfill. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled."

And Ruth not only said: "Your GOD is my GOD", but she also said: "your people are my people".

I see Ruth as a picture for us pagan Christians. So I can say with Ruth: "Your people is my people." I can say this, because Yeshua has torn down the wall that was between us; Yes, Yeshua has torn down this wall through HIS blood.

"Therefore we are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God" (Ephesians 2:19); or to say it with the word in Romans 11: Now we are grafted in the wonderful olive tree, which is Israel.

But if we belong to your people, shouldn't we also keep your laws, your rules and your traditions?!

But what did the pagan Christians do? Instead of loving Israel and the Jews, they left their spiritual roots planted another tree which they called "church". The Holy book warns us in Romans 11 not to boast against Israel; and whenever the word warns us to do something it is a serious warning – but the church did boast against Israel, even began to hate Israel and to mistreat them; and we did not celebrate the Jewish feasts anymore: We changed the 7th day from Shabbat to Sunday, we changed Pessach to Easter, and Shavuot into Pentecost and do not celebrate the feast of Sukkot at all anymore ... but instead celebrate Christmas, which is not a biblical feast.

Now of course in Acts 15:19 the believers out of the Greeks and Romans were told that they do not have to keep the law except "that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from blood."

But I believe that was just for the first steps to walk as believers; we did not have to study the law in order to join the body of Yeshua – because we were justified through faith and not by keeping the Torah. But instead of pointing out to Acts 15:19, the church should read also – and even more carefully - Acts 19:20. There we can learn the reason, why it was enough for the beginning to keep only the four rules in verse 19:

“For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every Sabbath day.”

As I understand this, we pagan Christian can join the body of Yeshua and we are grafted in the wonderful olive tree right away if we believe that Yeshua died for our sins. But then we are told to grow in our faith and also to study the Torah; only this way, Yeshua can grow in us and the Holy Spirit will direct our hearts and show us GOD's will for our lives (however I do not believe that we have to be circumcised because this is only for the natural offsprings of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob).

I believe it is time for the church to wake up and to repent and not only ask you to forgive us that we mistreated you, but also to act and to erase this new tree that we have planted, and come back to the wonderful olive tree and to change Sunday into Shabbat again and to get rid of Easter, but instead celebrate together with you the feasts of Pessach and Shavout – for Yeshua is your common Pessach lamb, that GOD has sent to both of us; it shall be one herd and one shepherd. Only this way we will be able to provoke the Jewish people to jealousy...

I am so thankful that our wonderful heavenly father has given me such a deep love for HIS people – and that through the cross I belong in a spiritual sense to HIS people. And I am so thankful that I know you and that I can pray for and subsidize you in what you do and it is my prayer that I was able to spend more time in Israel to provoke your people to jealousy.

I so much love the verse in Psalms 86:11: “Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name.” This verse clearly tells us to ask the LORD to show us HIS way for our life – but instead most Christians don't want to walk in HIS way, but in their own ways and ask GOD for the blessing of this fleshly way.

It's sad that both non-believing Jews (non-Messianic) & Gentiles often believe that when a Jew becomes a believer in Jesus as the Messiah, they are somehow excluded & removed "from the house of Israel". Dear Jacob,

This letter is translated by my son because he can speak - and write - English. It was us who were visiting you, I sang and E. danced at that time, and also it was us who sent you the film.

In the town I live in there is a mountain or rather a hill, and it is there where I usually go out to in the mornings to read the Siddur. I go the services of a Lutheran church, also sometimes I go to the synagogue; the people there know that I believe in Jesus. The truth is that I like much more to go to the synagogue than to the church and even today, during service, I was thinking how much better it would be to listen to the prayer in the synagogue, because there is greater sanctity there. I find it in my heart that I shall learn the Jewish prayers, and I shall recite them in Jesus, and also I find it in my heart that it would be attractive to the Jewish people. [...]I would like to learn the melodies of the old Jewish prayers. These prayers are all citations from the Bible.

When we were with you in Israel, even we realized that your service was of a very Western style. We were surprised by this. Because we desire the ancient Jewish things. We went into a synagogue at the inducement of the Holy Spirit. It turned out that the rabbi there was of Hungarian origin, 95 years old. We spent the full Shabbat with him, from morning to till evening. We experienced there the same things as you describe in the newsletter: fellowship, sanctity and holiness, brotherly-sisterly love, dance; and what was also very interesting is that it was an orthodox synagogue, but the brethren came in from another, non-orthodox synagogue, and we rejoiced, danced and sang together. Or, more exactly, only the men danced. They accepted us with very great love and joy.

A theological question:

Here - in the free churches - Paul is explained wrong: they say that if you keep a single command from the Law, for example lighting of the candles, or the Sabbath, you have to keep *all* the commands, and they are threatening us. I think we are free to light candles or keep the Sabbath. What should I answer to the people who have that threatening opinion? I already asked many people this question but none could answer me. My heart yearns for getting back to Israel, so that I be together with you again.

My dear brother Jacob and sister Elisheva!

I'm so happy to read your news in the newsletter! Thank you for sending it! Don't worry about the two parties; that is no debacle, but a development. Trust in your perceptions and feelings. The people [...] you described, are all right, they are a pleasure for God and Yeshua would say: Not the healthy people need the doctor, but the sick (Mt 9:12). These people are ok.

You wrote about the problem of identity. That is a very important question! Did the people who met Yeshua 2000 years ago and believed in him change their identity? Look at Zacchaeus, Lazarus, the woman in Mk 5:34 (...thy faith hath made thee whole, go in peace ...)

Can he say "go in peace", when there is no real peace? Lazarus did not leave everything to follow Yeshua and that was ok! Zacchaeus changed his life and He said: This day salvation has come to this house, for so much as he also is a son of Abraham. For the son of man has come to seek and to save that which was lost. There was no idea to leave Judaism!

Yeshua didn't tell them: At the moment you're ok, but next you have to leave your creed. He confirmed the people. They were the light of the world! It was His aim to raise the individual. The designation was for Israel to obtain its destination, its purpose: "...thou shalt be a blessing and I will bless them that bless thee..." (Gen 12:2+3)

Yeshua is the son of God (Psalms 2), of course! But he didn't say to his men: Tell them, I'm the son of God. He told them: Tell them the gospel. What is it? Heaven is near! Trust in God and trust in me! Are the acts of the apostles or the letters of Paul the gospel? No, they are necessary to explain the church. Zacchaeus did not need them!

What is more important, love or orthodoxy? Yeshua answers: Love by doing. Luke 10:25-37: A lawyer asked: what shall I do...? Yeshua answers, ask the law! The lawyer says: love the Lord and the neighbor. Yeshua: Do this! The man asks further: Who is it? And then follows the story of the priest, the Levite, the Samaritan. But the Samaritan was not orthodox (John 4:22): We know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. So we see: God looks at our hearts, not to our lips.

So we see: Yeshua was never against the law (Mt 5:17-20), only real love is more. He didn't change the law, he made it explicit. When God says: "do right", it is love, because he wants, that everyone does right with you! He didn't say: "do right", for us to point out who does wrong. So it isn't love when someone is looking out for people doing wrong. The enemy is never a person of man, it is the devil. A person that does wrong is a victim of the devil and needs help to come out. A person, who looks out for wrong people works for the devil. We should look out for God.

God and Yeshua want the same: to rescue from the evil. Make peace for both sides! Here you can recognize the father: When both sides are happy: (I will bless them that bless thee). Zacchaeus was happy to find love and the neighbors were happy that he changed his life.

When humans become friends and the devil is outside (Luke 11:20, Luke 17:21), then we have God's kingdom. When the church is happy and the Jews are outside or turned around, devil lives in both sides. [...]

So we must leave the imagination of the Christians being [...] the new substitute folk. [...]

Father says: Israel is my bride. Yeshua came and said: I am the groom. So Israel and Yeshua belong together. Yeshua loves endless, and his love is Israel. He is the delivery of Dtn 18:16. What did they pray for? For a king, who hates them? No, for a good king who lives among them eternally.

[...]

When Yeshua was at work, the people saw healings and wonders. Pagans came to find help there. So it was: A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of thy people Israel. Luke 2:32: You see? Joy on both sides. The Gentiles should receive healing, but through the Jews! They have to respect them. Therefore Yeshua helped the people to reach their destination. [...]

And now we have for 2000 years unhappiness at both sides. Let us bring Yeshua back to his folk, like the arc of the Lord in 2. Sam 6. You remember? When it was parked at the house of Obedom, that house had all blessings. I'm like Obedom: Yeshua lives in my house and I have endless blessing by the Lord. I live between all chairs. But his will is to return to his house. He is the pearl of Israel, the jewelry of your folk. When he is identified by Israel, the wonders in those days come back, your folk will arise and the world will see what the father is doing there. People will come from everywhere to bring respect and honor, both sides will be blessed. Peace for all. Do it like David in 2. Sam 6.

Collect the men, who believe in Yeshua and let them make music for the ears of Israel, forget the modern sound of the organization. Bring Yeshua back in a way they understand. You are elected to do that. I can see your love and your insight. Trust that God is with you, and he continues. Do not fear people [...] and show the world your light. Yeshua refused to tell the people who he is. Like the father he wants to be recognized. They will find him in our love, not in our "know-it-all".

I am very happy to read your news and the change I can see in your way of living in Israel. [...] Already a couple of years ago I wanted to ask you something but thought it would be too harsh of mine and was waiting for the right time to confront you with an idea.

I have read of your confrontation with Chasidim, Chabad people and even those who you think are your enemies, because they behave really badly.

On the other side I know about Christians [...] in strange parts of the world who lived like the people they wanted to reach with the good words and deeds of Mashiach Yeshua.

So you know better than me that Chasidim have a strong and very complex system of external appearance related on payot, dresses, and so on.

You know their basis in scripture although its interpretation are sometimes far related thru Talmud to the scriptures or the interpretation by a Rabbi. Anyhow I think it's not a sin to be dressed, or live like they do. Sometimes even I think they live nearer to the Word and to Mashiach than any other people who think that's not important and really dishonors HaShem and Mashiach with their lives even if their words proclaim him.

To be short:

Have you thought on looking and living like the Chasidim, but not out of a hypocrite motivation, but out of love for them and to respect their Judaism and the things which are holy for them, so as to show them how much HaShem and Yeshua HaMashiach loves them.

Maybe it is still too harsh of me and of course I have no right to tell you something like that. I just wanted to give an impulse in something you might already feel a direction about.
